

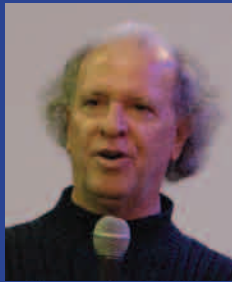
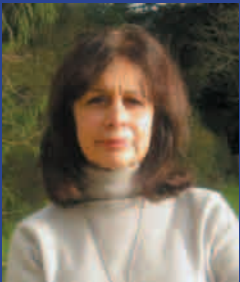
One Democratic State in Palestine/ Israel
